An author luncheon is scheduled for September 17th. The Oklahoma author presenting is Sheldon Russell, the 2024 Oklahoma Book Award Winner for Fiction.

The library will host a Bigfoot program from the Native Oklahoma Bigfoot Research Organization September 28th.

Youth Services Librarian Report

Summer Reading Program concluded on July 6th, with 201 participants in Kindergarten through 12th grade who read for 58,439 minutes.
